

Nonpublic Transportation

The law (NJ 18A:39-1.8) requires all public-school districts to offer either transportation or what is known as a “Aid in Lieu of Transportation” to students who attend a non-public school within 2 to 20 miles (for elementary and middle schools) from their North Caldwell home. The student must meet the age requirement of their **resident district** and be enrolled in grades kindergarten through 12 in their non-public school.

It is the obligation of the parent or guardian of nonpublic school students to annually obtain the Nonpublic School Transportation Application (B6T) from the administrative office of their nonpublic school for each student. A separate form for each student is required. Please be advised that **completed B6T forms should be returned to the private school on or before March 10th** for all students, or within 30 days of the student’s registration. **Any application received at the North Caldwell Board Office after March 15th is a late application.**

North Caldwell Board of Education will then notify the parent/guardian as to the determination of each application by August 1st. All eligible students will receive a B7T voucher along with their letter of determination. The completed B7T form must be returned to North Caldwell Board of Education to process first and second aid in lieu of transportation payments.

Eligible students will receive aid in lieu of transportation based upon the date the application is received by North Caldwell School District.
